1. In the beginning God created the _____ and the _____. (v.1)
2. Who moved upon the face of the waters? (the Spirit of God) (v.2)
3. What did God create on the 1st day of the creation week? (vs.3-5-light)
4. How do we know that the days of creation were literal days? (v.5-God defines a literal day—"the evening and the morning were the first day? The day starts for the Jews at 6pm in the evening and runs until the following day at 6pm)
5. What did God create on the 2nd day of the creation week? (vs.6-8-firmament)
6. What did God create on the 3rd day of the creation week? (vs.9-13-dry land and plant life—grass, trees, herbs)
7. What did God create on the 4th day of the creation week? (vs.14-19—starts, sun, moon)
8. What did God create on the 5th day of the creation week? (vs.20-23—sea creatures and flying creatures)
9. How does the term "after his kind" refute Darwinian evolution? (Darwinian evolution teaches that over a very long period of time one kind of animal changed into another kind of animal, but the bible teaches that God created all animals after their kind. We see many different breeds of dogs but they are all dogs. Changes within a kind is true, but changes from one kind to another kind (monkeys to man) is not true.)
10. What did God create on the 6th day of the creation week? (vs.24-31—land animals and man)
11. In whose image was man created? (v.27—God's image)
12. What was man's role to play in the earth? (v.28, also read Ps.8)
13. What did all of the animals and mankind eat at that time? (vs.29-30—plant life—herbs, trees, fruit)
14. Did the Lord Jesus Christ believe in a literal 7 day creation week? (Yes—Mt.19:1-6 / Mk.10:6 / Mk/13:19)
