

Genesis 15

- 1) Who is the steward of Abram's house? (v.2)
- 2) Who does the LORD say will be Abram's heir? (v.4)
- 3) What was it that Abram believed for which the LORD counted it to Abram for righteousness? (vs.5-6)
- 4) How does the LORD show Abram that he would inherit the land? (vs.8-10—see Jeremiah 34:18-19—rather than signing a contract to confirm an agreement, or covenant, the two parties would divide animals in half and walk between the parts to confirm the agreement.
- 5) What is the significance of the LORD going through the midst of the pieces of the animals by himself in the form of a smoking furnace and burning lamp? (It signified that this was an unconditional covenant that the LORD would perform. God gave the land of Canaan to Abram and his seed for an everlasting possession. It is not based on Abram's performance.)
- 6) How many years did God say that Abram's seed would be afflicted in a land that was not theirs? (v.13)
- 7) What did God say would happen to Abram's seed after 400 years of affliction? (v.16)
- 8) What are the boundaries of the land that God gave to Abram and his seed? (v.18)
